
Local ownership in solar route A37 (on state grounds)

Region: Emmen

The solar route A37 is set out as a 200 MWp solar park on state grounds on the fringes of the A37 highway. The aim is to realise 50% of the project in local ownership, that is legal or surrounding economic ownership by the communities through the local energy cooperatives in the municilatities of Emmen. Coevorden and Hoogeveen.

Current stage of pilot with respect to Civic Energy Cycle

Probably in the phase of developing enablers (a policy framework, tender design, setting up an umbrella cooperative for the project)
