

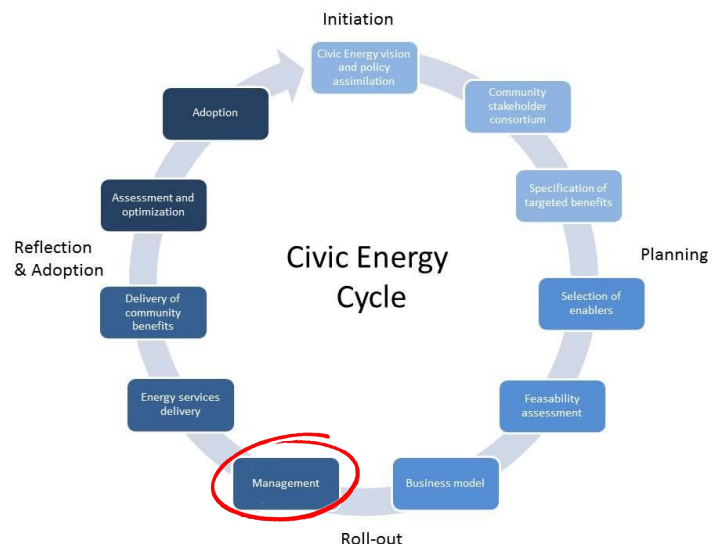
Cooperative solar development at industrial site De Tweeling

Region: Emmen

The industrial site De Tweeling is municipality owned, but there was no industrial development in the last ten years. The plan was to develop a 20 MWp solar park on the site, partly owned by the municipality and partly owned by local energy cooperatives.

The pilot stopped in the phase of policy assimilation.
