

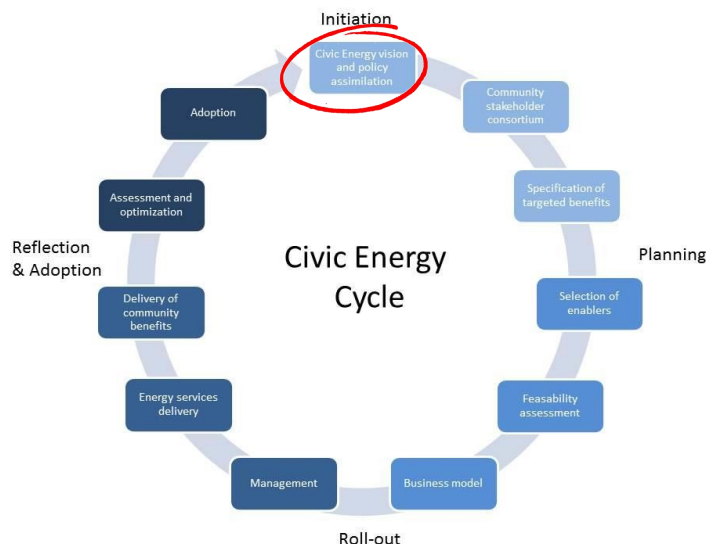
Maldegem – District heating network (on hold)
